As the year comes to the end, it is time to say goodbye to our leavers, we will miss them all, but wish them lots of luck in their new school adventures.

Extra insight into some of the things we have done this term.

- Watched & talked about the starlings going in and out of their nest in the top of the church building taking food to their babies.
- We looked at pictures of a robins nest from Mrs Mills garden, and talked about a nest at the allotments.
- Listened to different bird songs
- Looked at peacocks on the tablet and their sounds after reading 'Polar Bear Polar Bear'. Then talked about seeing and hearing the local peacocks.
- Watched the council mow the lawns, cut down trees and use the shredder, and sweep the roads. (whenever we hear something exciting happening beyond our walls we go and investigate, and talk about what we see and hear)
- We look for live creatures in our garden, this year we have seen lots of snails.
- We listen to the sounds and guess what they might be, i.e. a police car, fire engine etc. We listen to all sorts of different sounds like the boiling kettle, the tap running, the water in the pipes when a toilet has been flushed. When we hear these sounds we will talk about them, what we can hear, why its making that sound, and what it may sound like. Sometimes this is just one or 2 children, other times it will be the whole group. We are always listening and looking around our world for new and different things to talk about.
- Looking and listening to Aeroplanes and helicopters, looking at the trails they leave behind, guessing where they might be going.
